CAMP ADLER serves children and teens with, but not limited to, Autism, ADHD, and Learning Disabilities. Our goal is to create a fun, nurturing and supportive environment in a shared or inclusive camp program with typical day camp activities that provide the support needed to learn, build self-confidence and make lasting friendships.

CAMP ADLER PROVIDES:

Camp placement is based on social, emotional and cognitive abilities • Specialized counselors trained by qualified staff, including but not limited to special education teachers and adaptive sports instructors • Low camper-to-counselor ratio based on needs Consultation with related services providers

There is an intake required prior to registration to ensure best fit between the campers and program structure.

INCLUSION CAMPS

Full-School-Age Inclusion Camps — For children entering Grades K–6 in Sept., 2024 This option is geared only for children in a year round inclusion classroom setting.

Partial inclusion — ACES Hybrid –for children entering grades K-6 in Sept., 2024

Full-Tween Travel Inclusion Camp — For children entering Grades 7 or 8 in Sept., 2024

A full inclusion program for tweens includes exciting day trips and overnights vary from 2-4 day trips. Campers must get prior approval from the Camp Adler Program Director to be able to travel on all day and overnight trips.

SPECIALIZED GROUP CAMPS/SHARED CAMP EXPERIENCE

Adler Camp For Enrichment Services (A.C.E.S.) — For K-6 Grade

A unique summer camp experience for campers who need individualized attention in a shared environment. This group is for camper's who are in a self-contained environment with a low/camper to counselor ratio depending on needs.

Adler Camp For Enrichment Services (A.C.E.S.) HYBRID (Partial inclusion) — For K-6 Grade

A unique summer camp experience for campers using a blended model where they will participate part day as an inclusion camper and part day as a self-contained camper. This program is for campers who have a school placement in a self-contained class of 8-12 students. Campers will be pushed in to groups of their grade level.

A unique camp experience for pre-teens in a shared environment for camper's who need individualized attention in a structured self-contained environment. Program includes day trips, community service, swim sports & more!

ADDITIONAL CAMP INFORMATION

There are two lunch options available at **Mid Island Day Camp** for campers enrolled in Discoverers, Explorers, Juniors, Seniors, Camp Adler, Sport Rishon, Sport 34, Sport 56, Camp 56, Take A Bow, CIT's and Apprentices. For in-building Early Childhood Camp programs, a Kosher lunch is provided daily along with a morning and afternoon snack.

Lunch Programs

Please Note: All in-building MIYJCC camp programs that include lunch will provide a peanut/tree nut-free kosher lunch, and notifications of daily options will be offered on monthly menus.

Mid Island Day Camp: Option #1: Full Lunch

Served daily with a great variety of kid-friendly kosher meals. A typical meal includes an entree, side dish, salad, fruit, & drink. Each Friday is Pizza Day. On trip days, a boxed lunch is prepared. Every day we offer a sandwich or bagel, including a gluten free alternative.

Full-Day Camp fees include Kosher lunch options for all campers at camp and on trips up to 6th grade. Tweens Trailways program can opt in for the lunch program for the days at the campground. A discount is available for campers who bring a bagged lunch each day except Fridays when we serve pizza for Shabbat.

When we travel on overnights (Grade 7 and up) there is no kosher food program. We offer kosher lunch options when available.

Mid Island Day Camp: Option #2: Brown Bag

If homemade lunches are the way to go, please make sure it's kosher. All children who pack a lunch receive pizza on Fridays during the summer.

Mid Island Day Camp: Food Allergy Policies

The JCC Early Childhood Center is a nut-free environment. We will not be serving any snacks or lunches that contain nuts, and we respectfully ask that children who bring their own snacks and/or lunches ensure that all food is nut-free.

Mid Island Day Camp is "Peanut Aware." Peanut butter will not be served as an alternative lunch option for our campers. However, there may be traces of peanut and other allergens in foods served in our lunch program. Therefore, we recommend that children with allergies bring their own lunch. If there are children in your child's group with a severe peanut allergy, you will be asked NOT to send peanut butter products and we will send home a list of alternative lunch and snack options.

Before & After Camp Extended Care

At the Mid Island Y JCC This childcare program is available for children in summer camp programs (excluding Tween & Teen Travel).

- Extended care begins at 7:00 am and ends at 6:00 pm. Children are accompanied to their bus in the morning which takes them directly to their camp program.
- Rates vary by camp program.
- Please inquire about rates when you register for a specific camp offering.
- Registration for extended care is coordinated with the camp program that your child chooses.

At the Mid-Island Day Camp 75 Colonial Springs Road

For those children who are dropped off and picked up at the campgrounds by a parent each day. This service is free. Pre-registration is required. • Begins at 7:00 am — ends at 6:00 pm

Payment Information

ENROLLMENT POLICY AND FEES

Member applicants must have a valid and paid in full Family Membership at the Mid Island Y JCC through the end of the summer. Requests for adjusted fees based on financial need should be in writing by 4/1/24. Adjustments and scholarships are processed on a rolling basis. All non members will be charged a \$300 non member fee per child.

DEPOSITS & COMPLETION OF PAYMENT

Sailors and Pioneers require a 50% deposit. All other camps require a deposit of \$1,000 at time of registration. You then have two options for paying the balance.

AUTO CHARGE

By selecting this option, you agree to let us charge an equal percentage of your balance on your credit card each month until it is paid in full on June 1, 2024. A valid credit card must be on file.

THREE PAYMENT PLAN

By choosing this option you are leaving a \$1000 deposit and you agree to let us charge a second payment of \$1,500 per camper on February 1, 2024 and then the balance by April 1, 2024. A valid credit card must be on file. Payment of camp fees must be made by 4/1/24 to ensure camper(s) admittance to the program, unless on autocharge.

DISCOUNTS

A \$100 discount for each additional sibling is applied to families enrolled in any of our camp programs.

REFUNDS

Requests for refunds must be submitted in writing prior to 4/1/24. No refunds will be made after 4/1/24 for all MIYJCC camp programs due to pre-contracted services such as buses, staff, campground fees and other accommodations. Cancellations are subject to the following charges:

Before 4/1/24: \$100/Camper **After 4/1/24:** No Refunds

If we are required to close the agency, an entire program, or any portion thereof, for occurrences including but not limited to a pandemic, government shutdown, communicable diseases, safety, an act of God, weather related emergencies, and unknown circumstances beyond our control, there will be no refunds given.
